As foreshadowed in our last newsletter, we have commenced construction on our seventh new SDA house! Once completed, we will have replaced all our ageing residential accommodation with new SDA Improved Livability homes. This will bring our Asset Redevelopment Program to a conclusion – at least for the time being. It has been very gratifying to see such joy on the faces of our residents as they receive the keys to their new homes from our amazing builder, Ronnie Beaini. Many of you have commented on the noticeable improvement in relationships within the houses as the women enjoy their comfortable and spacious new living environments.

The construction at Koorong Street has progressed at pace and is perhaps the fastest build to date.

Ronnie is confident of handover during November 2023, noting that "we have finally managed to get everything co-ordinated perfectly – assisted of course by the magnificent weather".

This final house will provide Supported Independent Living (SIL) to males with intellectual disability, in line with our strategic plan. Expressions of Interest are now open, and I have received one promising application from a family associated with St Anthony's Catholic Church. # **RASAID SIL Integration**

#### We have successfully integrated the 14 residents from RASAID into the Seton Villa community.

A majority of disability workers previously employed by Participate Australia have now signed new employment contracts with Seton Villa and have been inducted into our Purpose, Vision and Values. They are now connected to our digital platforms via a new mobile phone app that displays their fortnightly roster with 'clock on' and 'clock off' functionality. This is a significant step change for these employees who have expressed their appreciation at joining such a professional organisation.

Residents are also very thankful to Seton Villa for our commitment to enriching their participant experience at RASAID. We recently arranged a visit from Fire & Rescue NSW and the Rural Fire Service to speak with residents about fire safety and the use of extinguishers.

By all accounts they had a fabulous day.
